Pillar Four - Building the Pillars of the Angelic



A 10-Day Devotional Journey of Understanding the Supernatural Enforcers of God

☆ Introduction

The pillar on the angelic is an enlightening journey of revelations about the angelic assignment that has increased in accordance with the decrees by the praying saints to release them. Though our focus is not on the different ranks and roles of angels, but to emphasize why they are sent and what they are doing in ministering the will of God on earth. God's revelation never aims at informing us regarding the nature of angels. Thus, the term *angelos* is not only a generic term, pertaining to a special order of beings (i.e., angels), but it is also descriptive and expressive of their office and service. So when we read the word "angel," we should think of it in this way.

When they are mentioned, it is always to inform us further about God, what He does, and how He does it; the emphasis is always on God and never on the angels. There are wise and precautionary reasons for this due to the Fall of Angels in history, and man's tendency to exalt them.

Angels are God's enforcers sent in this most supernatural era at greater levels than we have ever experienced before. Angels exist as supernatural creatures in and around the heavenly realms, and they are frequently dispatched to earth, sometimes even in human form, to bring heavenly assignments and assistance to both the corporate church and the individual believer.

Let your faith be activated to activate the angelic into their assignments.

Day 31: What are angels

Scripture: Hebrews 1:7,14; Psalm 104:4

Insight: There are many misconceptions about angels today due to an inferior or insufficient knowledge of angelology. Because a huge portion of the angelic have fallen from righteousness, they have corrupted and distorted the understanding of angels and their right standing. The word "angel" and its relation appear more than a hundred times in the Bible; hence, the Word of God is the only book that is both reliable and credible to give us a true account of the angelic and their roles.

In the above verses that give a clear definition of the angelic, concerning the angels, He said, who made His angels spirits. He gives them an inferior name and assigns to them a humbler office. They are mere ministers, and He has not ascribed to them the name of Son. They have a name which implies a humbler rank and office, the name "spirit," and the appellation of a "flame of fire." They obey God's will as the winds and the lightnings do.

The original intention of the passage is to show that the angels were the mere servants of God, rapid, quick, and prompt to do His will, like the winds. The Chaldee Paraphrase renders the passage in the Psalm, "Who makes His messengers swift as the wind; His ministers strong, like a flame of fire. It proves that the angels are the attendant servants of God; employed to become His heavenly ministers, to do His will, to accompany Him as the clouds and winds and lightnings do, and to occupy a subordinate rank in His creation.

It is essential to note that, although angels are referred to as the sons of God in the Old Testament, they were never granted the relational privileges of sons and daughters that God bestows upon us. This is why angels do not address God in the endearing term of "Abba," but they simply address God as Elohim or Mighty God.

Another important lesson is that we are not to exalt and worship angels or even engage in intimate communication with them, for many have fallen into this error and have interacted with false angels instead, who disguise themselves as angels of light (2 Corinthians 11:14).

Reflection:

- Are there any misconceptions that you have about angels?
- If yes, align yourself with what you read.
- If none, what new learnings did you glean from the insights?

Prayer: Father, thank you for this revelation of what the angelic is today, who are Your heavenly ministers assigned to assist me on earth. Help me to acknowledge their service and be thankful that they also protect me from great harm. Grant me a deeper understanding of their roles and assignments. In Jesus' name, I ask.

✓ Journal Prompt: Journal your new learnings from the day's devotion.



Day 32: The Nature of the Angelic Host

Scripture: 1 Peter 1:12; Luke 2:13-14; Jude 6

Insight: There are several qualities common to personality, all of which angels possess—personal existence, intellect, emotion, and will. Angels then qualify as beings with personalities because they have these aspects. This is true of both the good and evil angels.

Their Knowledge: Jesus said, "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone" (Matthew 24:36). This comment by the Lord suggests two things: (1) The phrase, "not even the angels" implies that angels have superhuman knowledge, but (2) the main statement of this verse shows they are limited in their knowledge, they are not omniscient. That their knowledge is greater is also suggested by the fact that they were present at some of the heavenly councils, were involved in conveying revelation (Galatians 3:19), and were used of God to interpret visions, as with Daniel and Zechariah.

Their Strength: Since man is created lower than the angels with limitations angels do not have, we would expect them to possess superhuman strength as well. That angels have greater strength than man is evident from at least two considerations: Scripture specifically speaks of their greater power. Psalm 103:20 at least implies their greater strength in the statement, "Bless the Lord, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word." 2 Peter 2:11 reads, "whereas angels who are greater in might and power.

But the reason why we expound on the personalities of the angelic is to know their capabilities and faithful stewardship of their assignments, and not to venerate them.

Reflection:

- With the day's devotion, what are the personalities of the angelic that you think are equivalent to humans?
- Are they lower than humans? Why or why not?

Prayer: Dear God, I confess with all my heart that Your angels are real and powerful, and that they carry holy assignments to do Your will and to assist me in accomplishing what I am unable to do in my own wisdom and strength. I am so grateful for the angelic assignment over my life, this I pray in Jesus' name.

Journal Prompt: Journal your reflections and new learnings.



Day 33: The Ministry of the Angelic

Scripture: Isaiah 6:3; Daniel 9:22; 10:13; Hebrews 1:14

Insight: The most basic characteristic of the angels is seen in the way they are described in Hebrews 1:14 as ministering spirits and in the accounts of their many and varied activities of ministry as described in Scripture.

Essentially, they function as priestly messengers (*leitourgika pneumatata*) in the temple-universe of God. From the account of their activities in the Bible, their service can be summarized as that of (1) the worship of God (Isaiah 6:3; Revelation 4:8), (2) as messengers of God (Daniel 9:22; Luke 1:11, 26; 2:9; Revelation 1:1), (3) as soldiers in spiritual combat (Daniel 10:13f; Revelation 12:7), and (4) as ministers to God's people (Hebrews 1:14), and (5) as instruments of His judgments (Revelation 7:1; 8:2).

Of course, the ministry of angels occurred at other times that are not mentioned directly in the Bible. God is not obliged to use angels; He can do all these things directly. However, it seems that He chooses to employ the intermediate ministry of angels on many occasions. Nevertheless, the believer recognizes that it is the Lord who does these things, whether directly through using angels (notice Peter's testimony that the Lord delivered him from prison, though God actually used an angel to accomplish it, Acts 12:7-10 compared with vv. 11 and 17).

B Reflection:

- Have you ever heard about ministering angels in the past?
- Have you experienced a ministry from an angel? Try to think of ways that God sent His angels to minister to you.

Prayer: Dear Lord, I thank You for the various roles and ministries of the angelic, especially as messengers that enlighten me about Your will and purpose for my life. Help me to be attentive to their ministry and to acknowledge that in my everyday living, in Jesus' name.

Day 34: The Assignments of the Angelic

Scripture: Psalm 103:20-21

Insight: As God's celestial servants who carry out His purposes, we may observe that their assignments fall into several different categories:

Assignment to the Nations: In relation to the nation of Israel, Michael, the archangel, seems to have a very important ministry as their guardian (Daniel 10:13, 21; 12:1; Jude 9). In relation to other nations, they watch over rulers and nations (Daniel 4:17) and seek to influence their human leaders (Daniel 10:21; 11:1).

In Relation to Christ: With the plan of God, centering in the person of His Son, Jesus Christ, they naturally perform many services for the Savior.

- o In relation to His birth, they predicted it (Matthew 1:20; Luke 1:26-28) and then announced his birth (Luke 2:8-15).
- In relation to His suffering, angels ministered to Him after His temptation (Matthew 4:11), in His agony in the Garden of Gethsemane (Luke 22:43).
- In relation to His resurrection, an angel rolled away the stone from the tomb (Matthew 28:1-2), and angels announced His resurrection to the women (Luke 24:5-7).
- o In relation to His coming again, the voice of the archangel will be heard at the translation of the church (1 Thessalonians 4:16), and they will accompany Him in His glorious return to earth (Matthew 25:31; 2 Thessalonians 1:7).

Assignment to the Unrighteous: Angels not only announce and inflict judgment (Genesis 19:13; Revelation 14:6-7; Acts 12:23; Revelation 16:1), but they will separate the righteous from the unrighteous (Matthew 13:39-40).


Assignment to the Church: Hebrews 1:14 describes their ministry as "ministering spirits, sent out to render service for the sake of those who will inherit salvation." In this, however, Scripture points to a number of specific ministries: they bring answers to prayer (Acts 12:5-10), they help in bringing people to the Savior (Acts 8:26; 10:3), though they are involved in many other tasks unlisted in the scriptures.

B Reflection:

- Which Angelic Assignment resonates with you that God is leading you to intercede and pray?
- What did you learn today?

Prayer: Dear heavenly Father, I thank You that Your angels are released to help me in my assignment to accomplish the things You ask me to do and the things I want to do for You. Help me to have a greater awareness of these alignments, I ask in Jesus' name.

Journal Prompt: Write a prayer that the Angelic Assignment will be accomplished in no time.



Day 35: Governmental Assignment

Scripture: Daniel 10:5-21, Revelation 12:7

Insight: One of the prominent roles of the angelic is to align the earth to heaven's governmental assignment. I will share from my personal account on this. An angel appeared to me on top of a mountain to reveal a kingdom's governmental assignment over my life concerning the coming great revivals.

Then, while praying in the All Nations Tower of Prayer, an angel, clothed in golden attire, appeared with a measuring rod and declared an ascension to levels of glory over us. These are governmental assignments and heavenly decrees over the nations to align us to God's plan and fulfil His purposes.


A keynote to learn from such angelic encounters is to know that God has trusted the recipient of such encounters with kingdom governmental assignments to establish the Kingdom's agendas and His governmental administration on earth.

B Reflection:

 What are the assignments that God is giving you to pray for your city or nation or state, or whatever area of influence He brought you?

Prayer: Dear Heavenly Father, I am both humbled and honored to be chosen by You to establish Your kingdom government on earth. Please help me to develop a kingdom mindset so that I can become Your heavenly governmental person here on earth, I ask in Jesus' name.

Solution Journal Prompt: Write a decree over the assignment that God gave you.



Day 36: Angelic Rod - Measure the Temple

Scripture: Revelation 11:1

Insight: Acknowledging the partnership of angels, where in Revelation 11:1, the angel gave his measuring rod to John to measure the temple of God. To measure the temple means to determine what substance and value it holds.

The Lord is releasing angelic assistance to help us measure churches and ministries according to His biblical standard, for He is the chief cornerstone where everything else is measured or aligned to.

We must submit to His righteous measurement for our churches, and anything that compromises with His biblical standard, that is out of alignment, must come back to His righteous plumb line (Amos 7:7-8).

Reflection:

- Seek the Lord for any misalignment in your life and ask Him to help you be aligned in His ways and will.
- If there are delayed alignments, decide to obey and align yourself with the Lord.

Prayer: Dear Lord, help me to have a thorough evaluation of my church and ministry and everything that I do. I pray that when You put Your measuring plumb line, You will find that I am aligned to Your biblical standard of righteousness and holiness. This I ask in Jesus' name.

Journal Prompt: Write a prayer of alignment with God.



Day 37: Angelic Rod - Measure the Altar

Scripture: Revelation 11:1

Insight: John was asked to measure the altar, which is the very essence of worship and prayers. The Lord is releasing angelic assistance to help us measure our prayer altars or prayer meetings to determine what sort it is.

The Holy Spirit is revamping prayers by infusing His wisdom, revelation, strategy, and anointing so that we will be led in Spirit-filled and Spirit-fueled prayers. The Lord is birthing and aligning prayer movement by synergizing various prayer networks globally to attune to heaven's agendas and decreeing His Kingdom to manifest and be established on earth (Mathew 6:10).


The Lord is also measuring our worship; is it born out of intimacy, where we worship in spirit and truth, or is it just mere lip service?

B Reflection:

- Start to reflect if you are worshiping in spirit and truth or just a mere lip service?
- What shall you do to improve yourself in worshiping God?

Prayer: Lord Jesus, help me to align my worship and prayers according to Your biblical standards and to what really pleases You. Help me to always submit to the Holy Spirit to lead me in my worship and prayer, I ask in Jesus' name.

Journal Prompt: Write your reflections.



Day 38: Angelic Rod - Measure the People

Scripture: Revelation 11:1

Insight: The last instruction given to John by the angel is to measure the people, the worshippers who worship. This measurement is to determine the character, motive, and expression of the people. This is to measure the authenticity of the worshippers in worshipping God; it entails the zeal and excitement in worship, as well as the passionate love of the worshippers.

The angelic are released to help God's people in worship, to help draw their vision and enthusiasm for God, and not superficial entertaining worship. The measurement is to determine whether there is hypocrisy and compromise in the lives of the people.

B Reflection:

- Is your character, motive, and expression of worship pure before God?
- What proactive application can you do to be better with your character, motive, and expression in worshiping God?
- Determine to do the application that came to you.

Prayer: Dear Lord, help me to nurture my faith in worship, to grow it like a precious seed that will bear much fruit. Help me to be authentic and passionate about You, just as I grow in righteousness in my character and personality, in Jesus' name.

Journal Prompt: Write your reflections and convictions.



Day 39: Angelic Rod - Measure the City & Economy

Scripture: Zechariah 2:1-5

Insight: After measuring the temple, altar, and the worshippers, there is another passage where angels are released to measure the city (abode) and the livestock (economy).

In Zechariah 2:2-4, the angels were measuring the width and length of Jerusalem, the abode of peace, which represents the dwelling of God's people outside the temple. This tells us that angels are assigned to provide and protect our well-being.


Then, the angels have oversight of the people and their livestock, which represent the affairs of the people and their economy. This passage assures us that God cares for our economy by sending angels to oversee both our health and wealth, in the natural as well as the spiritual.

B Reflection:

- Did you ever realize God's angelic assistance over your provision and protection?
- Could you think of any instances in which angels are sent to protect your economy?

Prayer: Dear Lord, I thank You that angels are assigned to care for my dwelling, to make it an abode of peace (Jerusalem), and to oversee my well-being in both my health and wealth. Help me to be submissive to Your loving guidance and provision in my life, in Jesus' name.

Solution Journal Prompt: Write a prayer to God over your provision and protection.



Day 40: Angelic Rod - Measure the River

Scripture: Ezekiel 47:1-9

Insight: The angel assigned to measure the river also determined the flow and depth of the river according to the depth a believer walks in the Spirit and toward the purpose of God. The deeper we walk with the Lord into His river, the greater the velocity of the power of the river.

This river is the river of signs and wonder, the river of healings and miracles that flows in mighty revivals across cities and nations. This is the river that God wants to unleash to reveal His glory, and He will assign the angelic to bring it to its intended purpose, but we have to align ourselves with Him and be willing to go deeper than ankle depth until we swim with the flow.


Proverbs 21:1 also encourages us to completely surrender our hearts into the Lord's hand so He can turn the river whichever He wishes.

B Reflection:

- Are you waiting for these rivers to happen in your church or city, or nation?
- What are you doing about it?

Prayer: Dear God, thank You for the River that flows from Your throne room into my life. I pray that as I go deeper in my walk and faith in You, the deeper the River will flow in me until I am totally submerged in the River of Your glory, I ask this in Jesus' name.

△ Journal Prompt: Write a prayer for God's Rivers to flow to your church, city, and nation. Pray it from the bottom of your heart.



Closing: Angelic Pillar is an unseen angelic army assigned to assist you that will keep you going. Welcome the presence of angels, acknowledge that they are sent by God to serve His purposes in you and through you. It is one of the privileges of your walk and relationship with Him. Nurture it. Treasure it. Build it. Strengthen it. Use it. Live it. Claim it. Grow in it. Be it. Let the supernatural be natural in you, in Jesus' name, amen!


